

Nonconsumptive Outdoor Recreational Activities at Fort Riley Require:

1. Federal ID Card or Fort Riley Visitor's Pass

- A visitor's pass may be obtained from the Fort Riley Visitor's Control Center, Building 885, exit 301, I-70.

2. iSportsman Account (fortriley.isportsman.net)

- A Daily Check in and Check out on Fort Riley iSportsman.

3. Fort Riley Recreation Motor Vehicle Marking

- All motor vehicles used for outdoor recreational activities shall display a current Fort Riley iSportsman permit in the front windshield.

Nonconsumptive outdoor recreational activities include but are not limited to bird watching, nature photography, hiking and mushroom collecting.



Fishing on Fort Riley Requires:

1. Federal ID Card or Visitor's Pass

- A visitor's pass may be obtained from the Fort Riley Visitor's Control Center, Building 885, exit 301, I-70.

2. iSportsman Account (fortriley.isportsman.net)

- A Daily Check in and Check out on Fort Riley iSportsman.

3. Kansas Fishing License*

- All motor vehicles used for outdoor recreational activities shall display a current Fort Riley iSportsman permit in the front windshield.

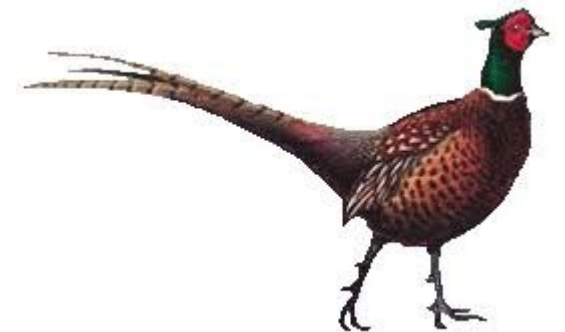

4. Firearms Registration (FR Form 102-1)
5. Fort Riley Recreation Motor Vehicle Marking
 - All motor vehicles used for outdoor recreational activities shall display a current Fort Riley iSportsman permit in the front windshield.
6. Fort Riley Hunting Access Permit*
7. Kansas Hunting License*
8. Greater Prairie Chicken Permit (If Applicable)

 - All motor vehicles used for outdoor recreational activities shall display a current Fort Riley iSportsman permit in the front windshield.
7. Fort Riley Hunting Access Permit*
8. Kansas Hunting License*
9. Kansas Furharvester License*
10. Fort Riley Trapping Permits (only required for trapping)
 - First Come, First Serve

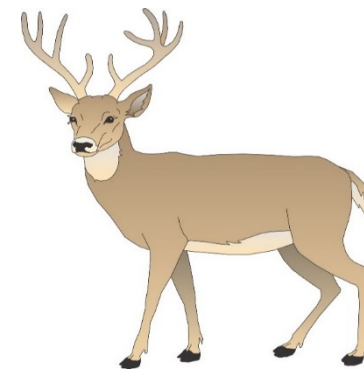
Archery Hunting Requires:

4. Firearms Registration (FR Form 102-1)
5. Fort Riley Recreation Motor Vehicle Marking
 - All motor vehicles used for outdoor recreational activities shall display a current Fort Riley iSportsman permit in the front windshield.
6. Fort Riley Hunting Access Permit*
7. Kansas Hunting License*
8. Kansas Elk Permit (Unit 2, draw only)
