

The access control changes that the installation has been experiencing over the last 5 months, within the main cantonment area of Fort Riley, will now expand to include all maneuver/training areas north of Vinton School Road effective 1 July 2015. Those that will be affected by this change will be all persons that are on the military reservation that do not possess a DOD ID Card or Access Passes or badge.

Those personnel that do not have the required ID or Access Passes can apply for one and are available from the installation's Visitor Control Center (Bldg 885), located just south of the Henry Gate Access Control Point (Exit 301, U.S. Interstate 70) and is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Access Passes are based on the requirement of the visit.

If you know the exact date of your visit, it is highly recommended to get a temporary pass or badge early by stopping by the Visitor Control Center, calling (785)239-2982 or emailing [usarmy.riley.imcom-central.mbx.des-vcc@mail.mil](mailto:usarmy.riley.imcom-central.mbx.des-vcc@mail.mil). You will be required to provide a government issued photo identification and vehicle registration and insurance if you plan on driving on the installation. You will be able to apply for a pass based on your need for access and will receive a pass for the duration of that need. Please note there are longer wait times for passes during periods of higher traffic – especially weekday morning and weekday afternoons when soldiers and civilian employees are traveling to work and physical fitness activities. If you are unable to get a pass early, make sure to allow extra time the day of your visit to get through the processing procedure at the Visitor Control Center.

To gain access to any maneuver/training area north of Vinton School Road and East of US Highway 77, personnel will be required to use one of the following access points once proper passes have been obtained.

Four corners which is located at the intersection of Vinton School Road and 1st Division Road.

Old Highway 77 north of Vinton School Road.

To gain access to any maneuver/training area north of Vinton School Road and West of US Highway 77, personnel will be authorized to use any approved access road once proper passes have been obtained.

Foot access through an open area to recreate on the military reservation north of Vinton School Road will still be authorized provided your vehicle is legally parked and you are in possession of the proper Identification or Access Pass.

All requirements regarding the check-in/out procedures for recreationists can be found at [fortriley.isportsman.net](http://fortriley.isportsman.net) and will remain in full effect.

All visitors 16 years of age and older who wish to enter any portion of the Fort Riley Military Reservation must possess an approved DoD ID card or a Fort Riley Access Pass or Badge. Currently, the only exception to this new requirement will be for individuals who only wish to access the Military Marina area of Milford Lake which is located south of U.S. Highway 82 and west of U.S. Highway 77.

All violators of the new access policy will be warned during the implementation phase of 1-31 July 2015. The violator will be issued an information paper of the new procedures and escorted off of the military reservation.

Effective 1 August 2015, violators will be issued a ticket for Unauthorized Entry onto Military Property, Title 18 USC 1382, which will result in a mandatory court appearance before the US Magistrate as directed. The violator will then be escorted off of the military reservation. A violation may also result in loss of recreational privileges.
